LESS INVASIVE

Laparoscopic surgery is a minimally invasive procedure that causes as little trauma to the patient as possible.



SMALLER INCISIONS

A fiber-optic cable with a light and camera is passed through a small incision in the abdominal wall, allowing the veterinary surgeon an excellent view of the reproductive anatomy.



LESS PAIN

Instead of traditional sutures, blood vessels & nerves are cauterized and sealed using an instrument passed through the laparoscope.

BENEFITS

- Reduces pain
- Less traumatic
- Less risk of infection & other postsurgical complications
- Faster recovery
- Much smaller incision than a traditional spay
